Errata to Form of Service Agreement for Reserve Sharing Energy Service

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act ("FPA"), 16 U.S.C. § 824d, and Section 35.13 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") Regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 35.13 (2008), and consistent with the Commission's February 21, 2008 order in Docket Nos. ER91-195 and EL07-69, *Western Systems Power Pool Agreement*, 122 FERC ¶ 61,139 (2008) ("WSPP Agreement Order"), on February 25, 2009, in the above-referenced docket, Xcel Energy Services Inc. ("XES"), on behalf of Southwestern Public Service Company ("SPS"), filed a proposed form of Service Agreement as a new Attachment S to the Xcel Energy Operating Companies Joint Open Access Transmission Tariff ("Joint OATT"), for parties participating in the Southwest Power Pool's Reserve Sharing Group, under which SPS supplies reserve sharing energy ("February 25 Filing").

XES has discovered an inadvertent error in Section 7.0 of the Form of Service Agreement for Reserve Sharing Energy Service. XES inadvertently used the term "Transmission Customer" in that section instead of the term "Reserve Sharing Customer." Accordingly, XES is submitting a revised Form of Service Agreement to correct the error. For the convenience of the Commission, XES is submitting a redline showing this correction.
