> Summary of 60-Day Notice: Commercial Refrigeration Efficiency New Product

Public Service Company of Colorado (PSCo) proposes to offer a new direct savings product in 2013 called Commercial Refrigeration Efficiency to be added to the Company's Business Program. This product and its third-party implementer were selected from proposals received in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP) for Innovative Technology agreed to in the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement in Docket No. 11A-631EG. The Settlement stated:

Additionally, in order to help address the energy savings shortfall for 2013, the Company agrees to issue a Request for Proposals during the first quarter of 2012 intended to solicit program proposals for achieving electric energy savings during 2013 by means of innovative program ideas for niche markets or market where the company is under serving a customer segment.... The company commits to bring forward one or more new programs if, after Company review, it appears that such programs are likely to be cost effective and will help the Company meet its 2013 energy savings goal. New programs may be implemented as either pilot of full scale programs, and will be added to the DSM portfolio by means of the 60-day notice process.¹

This Commercial Refrigeration Efficiency Product will offer on-site assessments, direct installation of low-cost measures, refrigeration maintenance and prescriptive refrigeration rebates to commercial customers with significant refrigeration loads, notably restaurants, and grocery, convenience, and liquor stores. The third-party chosen from their bid to the RFP for Innovative Technology will perform complimentary refrigeration assessments at customer locations and implement energy-efficient improvements for identified refrigeration equipment. The product will launch in June 2013.

Public Service does not propose to increase its 2013 approved budget or goals. However, we are anticipating that 156 participants will contribute 498 net generator kW of demand savings and 4.6 million kWh of electric savings. The proposed spend for this new product is \$917,671, which will be accommodated within the 2013 budget flexibility.
